A writer whose life experiences inspire his work to humanise characters lost or at odds with a flawed social system. Andrew is passionate about creating stories that centre on marginalised and underrepresented groups - stories that not only entertain but spark debate and conversation.

Andrew co-founded the Three Peas Theatre Company and started writing as a way to create substantial acting roles for himself. His debut play, **Death Row Cowboy** - which he co-produced, wrote, and performed - premiered at the Smock Alley Theatre in January 2014 and returned for an extended run in August. The play also made its UK debut in London's Courtyard Theatre in 2015. In addition to theatre, Andrew has produced and created the mini-documentary **Rebirth** which aired on RTE, and co-produced and wrote the multi award-winning short film **Brenda**, which also aired on RTE in 2018.

With support from Screen Ireland, Andrew developed his debut feature film **Fishscale** as part of the Spotlight Development Scheme. He also wrote the micro short award-winning film **Meat Market**, which completed a successful festival run and was a collaborative effort with fellow filmmakers on the 2021/22 BFI Network x BAFTA Crew. In addition, Andrew recently completed the BBC Writersroom Voices program in 2023, where he developed the TV series **Route '94**.

Currently, he is working on several exciting projects, including a TV series optioned by Yellow Film & TV, the largest independent studio in the Nordic region.
